



CONDITIONS OF LICENCE UNDER THE GAMBLING REGULATORY AUTHORITY ACT 2007

The conditions imposed on Gaming House “B” by the Gambling Regulatory Board under section 97 of the Gambling Regulatory Authority Act 2007.

NAME OF GAMING HOUSE ‘B’

1. You should pay the required licence fee of Rs 15,000 payable in four (4) equal instalments, each instalment being payable on or before the first day of any period of 3 months as provided as per Third Schedule of the Gambling Regulatory Authority Act 2007.
2. You are authorised to offer only the following prescribed games, namely Mahjong and Rummy.
3. You should submit to the Board a certified copy of the rules of the gaming house games you intend to offer for approval by the Gambling Regulatory Board before starting operation.
4. You should at all times when the gaming house is opened for the playing of gaming house games, display in a conspicuous place in the gaming house:-
 - (a) Your licence and the conditions of licence.
 - (b) The gaming house games authorised to be played and the main stakes approved by the Board.
 - (c) Rules of gaming house games.
5. No person under the age of 21 should enter or attempt to enter in the gaming house to participate in gambling.
6. Gambling credit facilities are prohibited.
7. No person concerned in the management or control of the gaming house, employed in the gaming house should participate in the playing of any game in the gaming house.
8. You should comply with the provisions of the Private Security Service Act 2004 as regards employment of Security Guards. You should also submit to the Gambling Regulatory Authority a list of the duly registered Security Guards.
9. The hours of operation are as follows:-

Monday to Friday	-	19.00 hrs to 5.00 hrs
Saturday, Sunday and Public Holiday	-	12.00 hrs to 5.00 hrs



10. The access to your Gaming House should be completely separate from those of any other premises.

11. The Gambling Regulatory Authority reserves the rights to:-

- (a) direct the relocation of your premises to such area as it may determine; and
- (b) limit the number of renewals in future in conformity with any applicable law.

12. It is understood that the grant of the licence does not exempt you from compliance with any other law or from obtaining authorisations, licences or permits from other relevant authorities.
