GENERAL

Trainer A. Nagadoo signed an Admission of Guilt for a contravention of Rule 47.9.1.3 in that he failed to notify that the horse ZACATOO had been gelded. He was fined MUR 15,000.

The following trainers and jockeys appeared before the Stipendiary Stewards to confirm their instructions and discuss their intentions in their respective races:

RACE 1: THE SUPERSCORE TROPHY - BENCHMARK 51 - 1500M

SECRET GIVER: Was urged forward from the start but failed to muster speed. From leaving the 1200m, raced fiercely and when being restrained, threw its head sideways. Passing the 600m, commenced to give ground to the field. The Regulatory Veterinarian was requested to examine this gelding.

SPIRIT'S UNITE: Was slow into stride. Approaching the 900m, was momentarily switched outwards to avoid the heels of SHAH AKBAR. Leaving the 400 m was switched to the outside of SHAH AKBAR to improve its position and raced wide into the home straight.

LET'S PLAY POKER: Passing 250m, was switched to the inside of SHAH AKBAR to secure clear running.

RACE 2: THE RAM RUHEE MEMORIAL TROPHY - BENCHMARK 31 - 1400M

The starter reported that BESTDAY OF MYLIFE jumped awkwardly.

BROADWAY ALLEY: Raced fiercely from leaving the 1200m and proved difficult to settle. Approaching the 700m, was switched to the outside of UNSUNG HERO and in doing so carried, UNSUNG HERO wider on the track. Carried wide from approaching the 300 and raced wide into the home straight.

CHARLIE SQUADRON: raced wide from the 600m.

SECRET CIRCLE: Passing the 1300m was inconvenienced and had to be steadied off the heels of GANG LEADER which was taken inwards to secure a position closer to the rails. Jockey Horil was shown video footage of this incident, reprimanded and advised to ensure he is well clear of horses before shifting ground in future. Near the 300m was taken to the outside of GANG LEADER to improve its position and in doing so carried BROADWAY ALLEY wider on the track.

UNSUNG HERO: Bumped shortly after the start. Carried wide at the 700 metres.

ROYAL PORT LOUIS: Shifted in shortly after the start and bumped UNSUNG HERO, which had shifted ground outwards, becoming unbalanced and stumbling. Shortly after when being urged forward, shifted ground outwards slightly crowding SECRET CIRCLE with SECRET CIRCLE having to be steadied. Jockey Santana was shown video footage of this incident, reprimanded and advised to straighten his mounts when they shift ground in future. Raced wide from the 600m to the 300m.



GANG LEADER: Jumped awkwardly shifted ground inwards and brushed SECRET CIRCLE. Passing the 250m, was switched to the outside of UNSUNG HERO to secure a run into a tight gap between UNSUNG HERO and ROYAL PORT LOUIS.

BESTDAY OF MYLIFE: Jumped awkwardly and from its wide draw was taken across behind runners.

RACE 3: THE TELETOTE TROPHY - BENCHMARK 36 - 1365M

WARRIOR CAPTAIN: stumbled Shortly after the start. Near the 1100m was momentarily tight on the inside of MASTERFUL GUY.

MASTERFUL GUY: Threw its head on jumping.

SAND PATH: Failed to muster speed at the start and leaving the 1300m was taken across to race behind runners. Hung outwards in the home straight.

RIVER HAWK: From leaving the 500m was switched to the outside of SAND PATH to improve its position and raced wide in the home straight.

RACE 4: THE SUPERTOTE OFF-COURSE TROPHY - BENCHMARK 56 - 1365M

CAPTAIN COLA: Slightly inconvenienced near the 100m



ZOOMIE: From its wide draw was taken across to race behind runners. Approaching the 400m was taken to the outside of runners to improve its position, and raced very wide into the home straight.

AMPERSAND: was slow into stride. Leaving the 250m was switched to the inside of NINETY NINE HEROS to continue going forward.

JUST VAR: Near the 350m was taken out from behind CAPTAIN COLA to improve its position and carried ZOOMIE wider on the track. Raced wide into the home straight. From leaving the 200m, commenced to shift ground inwards and near the 100m, slightly inconvenienced CAPTAIN COLA.

NINETY NINE HEROS: Slow into stride

RACE 5: THE SUPERTOTE MOBILE APP TROPHY - [MIDDLE STAKES] - 1850M

PRIME EXAMPLE: Slow into stride. Leaving the 900m was switched to the outside of runners and urged forward to improve its position and raced wide from the 600m.

ZAKHO: Jumped awkwardly and shifted ground inwards and bumped FAVOUR's hindquarters unbalancing the latter. Was slow into stride. Inconvenienced shortly after the start. Near the 450 was switched to outside of runners to improve its position and carried MENELAUS and PRIME EXAMPLE wider on the track.

MENELAUS: Carried out shortly after the start. Leaving the 450m carried wide, commenced to give ground and was not persevered with in the home straight.

FAVOUR: Bumped and unbalanced shortly after the start.

ROMAN'S REVENGE: Shortly after the start commenced to shift ground outwards, and carried MENELAUS out onto FAVOUR with ZAKHO, which was following, was slightly inconvenienced when close to its heels and having to be steadied. Jockey Schwarz was shown the video footage of this incident, reprimanded and advised to straighten his mounts when they shift ground in future. Approaching the 1600m when being settled, raced ungenerously, throwing its head on a number of occasions. Approaching the 1500m, was momentarily awkward close to the heels of TRANSONIC.

RACE 6: THE SUPERTOTE GOLDEN TROPHY – [G2] - 2200M

The start of the race was delayed due to ALLEZ MORIS's saddle being refitted at the start.

MERIDIUS: Carried wide in the middle stages and on the final turn into the home straight.

ZEUS was slow into stride. Raced wide from the 400m. Leaving the 200m, was switched to the inside of runners to continue going forward.

GOOD COUNCIL raced wide from the 600m. Passing the 250m, was switched to the inside of SUGAR BLAST to secure clear running.

ALLEZ MORIS Leaving the 900m was switched to the outside of GOOD COUNCIL and in doing so, carried MERIDIUS wider on the track. Raced wide from the 500 metres.

RACE 7: THE SUPERTOTE TROPHY - BENCHMARK 46 - 1365M

FINE ONE: Jumped awkwardly shifting ground inwards and brushing the right side of its stall. Passing the 1200m shifted in abruptly, resulting in WUGUG which was following having to be eased. TSUNAMI WARNING which was following clipped heels of WUGUG and stumbled badly unbalancing Apprentice Ecroignard. An inquiry was held into this incident. Evidence was taken from Jockeys Perez, Nunes and Apprentice Ecroignard. The Stipendiary Stewards reviewed the various angles of the video footage of the race and further questioned Jockey Perez. After considering the explanations of Jockey Perez, the Stipendiary Stewards decided not to proceed any further with the inquiry and decided to report the matter as a racing incident.



IDITAROD TRAIL: Leaving the 250m was switched to the outside of runners to secure clear running.

WUGUG: Eased passing the 1200m. Bumped shortly after the start.

TSUNAMI WARNING: Bumped shortly after the start. Approaching the 1200m clipped the heels of WUGUG, stumbled badly unbalancing Apprentice Ecroignard. Raced fiercely near the 1100m and had to steady when awkwardly placed close to the heels of WUGUG. Leaving the 250m was switched to the inside of runners to secure clear running

CANFORD LIGHTS: Slow into stride. Leaving the 900m was switched to the outside of runners and urged forward to secure a position closer to the lead. Leaving the 150 m was switched to the inside of runners to continue going forward.

CANARY ISLAND was slow into stride.

RACE 8: THE LINES OF POWER PLATE - [0 - 20] - 1400M

Following pre-race sample analysis, the Stipendiary Stewards were informed that a Residual Limit of 29ng/ml of Caffeine, a prohibited substance under the Rules of Racing, was detected in CLOUD SEEDER. Pursuant to Rule 69.9 of the Rules of Racing, Trainer A. Sewdyal was informed of the Findings and acting under Rule 12.11 of the Rules of Racing, the Stipendiary Stewards ordered the scratching of horse CLOUD SEEDER effective 11:30am on 18 October 2025. All monies invested on CLOUD SEEDER were ordered to be refunded. A deduction of 12 cents per rupee was declared. An inquiry will be held at a date to be set.

CAPTAIN'S CONSORT: Raced wide from the 600m. Hung inwards in the home straight and approaching the 100m, became awkwardly placed close to the heels of AMANDLA and had to be switched inwards to continue going forward.

ZACATOO: Leaving the 100m when being ridden with a whip in the right hand, shifted ground outwards resulting in Jockey Danielson shifting his whip in left hand.

OVERDOSE: Raced wide from 600m.

HIGH VOLTAGE stood flat footed and was slow to begin, losing considerable ground.

ANDERSON Raced wide in the early stages. Raced fiercely in the middle stages. Leaving the 200m had to be switched to the inside of runners to secure clear running.



LE QUARTIER: Raced fiercely in middle stages.
