GENERAL

The following trainers and jockeys appeared before the Stipendiary Stewards to confirm their instructions and discuss their intentions in their respective races:

Race 4: FINE ONE (Trainer Mahadia and Jockey Perez)
GLOBAL DOLLAR (Trainer Mahadia and Jockey Taka)

Race 7: AMANCIO (Trainer Gujadhur and Jockey Nunes)

RACE 1: THE CORBAN PLATE 1650M – [BM 41]

ALL ABOUT LOVE – Was slow into stride. Approaching the 1300m, became awkwardly placed close to the heels of MASTERFUL GUY. Was momentarily taken out to avoid its heels and in doing so, carried COLOUR OF MONEY wider on the track, thereafter, COLOUR OF MONEY was then eased and taken in, to secure a position of the rails at the back of the field. Passing the 400m, ALL ABOUT LOVE was switched to the outside of MASTERFUL GUY to improve its position and raced wide into the home straight.

COLOUR OF MONEY – Approaching 1300m, carried wider on the track.

RACE 2: THE TOTELEPEP SMS CUP 1500M – [0-25]

CATCHA DRAGON – Jumped awkwardly and was slow into stride. Jumped the crossing at the 1300m. Passing the 1200m, was carried wider on the track. Approaching the 400m, was switched out to improve its position and raced wide into the home straight.

PAI MEI – Approaching the 800m, was crowded for room and checked on the inside of MALINOIS, which had shifted in when being urged forward. Leaving the 600m, was switched to the outside of MALINOIS to improve its position and in doing so slightly inconvenienced KOLA TONIC.

KOLA TONIC – Near the 800m, was inconvenienced and had to be eased when MALINOIS was improving on its outside and shifting ground inwards. Inconvenienced approaching the 600m.

When questioned regarding the apparent poor performance of this gelding, Jockey Santana explained that KOLA TONIC was having its second run in Mauritius. He stated that the gelding had pleased in its work leading up to the race and a forward showing was expected. He further explained that, after previewing the race with his trainer, it was decided to race close to the pace.

On the actual running of the race, he stated that after jumping well, he managed to secure a one-off position near the leaders. However, the gelding was interfered with near the 800m and had to be eased, and was again inconvenienced near the 600m when PAI MEI shifted out in

front of him. He added that when asked for an effort near the 450m, KOLA TONIC failed to quicken as expected and proved disappointing.

He concluded that, in his opinion, the fact that KOLA TONIC was running only two weeks after its first race in Mauritius, might have been too soon for the gelding.

MALINOIS – Passing the 1200m, was switched to the outside of SMUTS and in doing so, carried CATCHA DRAGON wider on the track, which was then eased, and taken in, to secure a position closer to the rails. Leaving the 900m MALINOIS was taken to the outside of horses to improve its position and passing the 800m was taken in, resulting in KOLA TONIC becoming cramped for room, having to be eased to avoid its heels and shortly thereafter, PAI MEI becoming cramped for room on its inside and having to be checked. At an inquiry into this incident, Jockey Gates was found guilty of a breach of Rule 43.2.5 in that he carelessly allowed his mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of KOLA TONIC and PAI MEI passing the 800m, and was suspended to ride in races for 1 Mauritian race meeting and fined Rs 25,000.

SMUTS – Proved difficult to load and was fractious in his gates prior to the start of the race.

HIGH VOLTAGE – Was slow to begin.

RACE 3: THE PHONELEPEP CUP 1365M – [BM 36]

CANFORD LIGHTS – Raced wide in the early stages and leaving the 1200m, was eased and taken in, to secure a position one-off the rails behind SUMMER SNOW. Passing the 600m, was switched to the outside of runners to improve its position and raced wide from then onwards. Approaching the 300m, commenced to give ground.

SUMMER SNOW – Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages.

CHARLIE SQUADRON – Was slow into stride.

GANG LEADER – Approaching the 1300m, was eased and taken in, to secure a position closer to the rails. However, in doing so, became awkwardly placed close to the heels of SUMMER SNOW. Jockey Horil was shown the footage of the incident, reprimanded and advised to take more care when shifting ground in the future. Approaching the 200m, was switched to the inside of NOT IN DOUBT to secure clear running.

RACE 4: THE SPORTSLEPEP SMS FOOTBALL CUP 990M – [BM 46]

WARHEAD – Jumped awkwardly inwards and shifted ground inwards.

HARDFALLINGRAIN – Was bumped badly by FINE ONE and had to be checked near the 900m. An inquiry will be held when Jockey Mansour is available.

FINE ONE – Jumped inwards, shortly after the start and was brushed by WARHEAD when WARHEAD was straightened. When being brushed, FINE ONE became unbalanced, shifted ground outwards bumping HARDFALLINGRAIN with HARDFALLINGRAIN shifting ground outwards and having to be checked when awkwardly placed close to the heels of GOOD LIVING.

GLOBAL DOLLAR – Was slow into stride.

GOOD LIVING – From the 450m, commenced to shift ground outwards and had difficulty in making the turn into the home straight despite Jockey Mansour's attempt to assist it.

RACE 5: THE TOTELEPEP OFF COURSE CUP 1365M – [BM 51]

ILLICIT KISS – Leaving the 250m, was switched inwards to secure clear running.

GRAND BAY – Approaching the 450m, was switched to the outside of runners to improve its position.

LETS PLAY POKER – Leaving the 650m, was carried wider on the track and raced wide into the home straight.

COMEDY CLUB – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin. Commenced to give ground from passing the 450m.

HAVANA MOON – Was fractious in its gate after being loaded and reared prior to the start of the race.

FURIE NOCTURNE – Was fractious in its gate and half-reared as the start was effected, being slow into stride. Leaving the 650m, was switched to the outside of COMEDY CLUB to improve its position and in doing so, carried LETS PLAY POKER wider on the track, with LETS PLAY POKER racing wide into the home straight.

RACE 6: THE TOTELEPEP.MU CUP 1365M – [BM 66]

BETATHANTHEREST – After jumping, Apprentice Ecoignard became unbalanced, falling back in his saddle with BETATHANTHEREST throwing its head, shifting inwards and bumping COMMON GROUNDS. Passing the 1300m, BETATHANTHEREST shifted ground inwards despite Apprentice Ecoignard's attempt to straighten it. Was carried wide on the track leaving the 600m.

ZOOMIE – Jumped inwards, brushing the right side of its gate, shifted ground inwards bumping COMMON GROUNDS with the latter bumping DANILO DANILOVITCH. DANILO DANILOVITCH then shifted ground inwards and bumped GLOBAL GLORY on its hind quarters slightly unbalancing the latter. Leaving the 600m, ZOOMIE was switched to the outside of GLOBAL GLORY to improve its position. COMMON GROUNDS which was following, was slightly inconvenienced.

DANILO DANILOVITCH – Jumped outwards slightly. Approaching the 1300m, was taken out from behind GLOBAL GLORY and in doing so, crowded COMMON GROUNDS onto BETATHANTHEREST which was racing in a 3-wide position at that time. Leaving the 200m, commenced to shift ground inwards, with Jockey Curatola shifting his whip into his right hand, COMMON GROUNDS which was following, was angled inwards to endeavour to secure a run between DANILO DANILOVITCH and the running rails, clipped its heels, stumbled badly and dislodged Jockey Mansour.

COMMON GROUNDS – Passing the 1300m raced momentarily in restricted room between BETATHANTHEREST and DANILO DANILOVITCH which was taken out from behind GLOBAL GLORY. An inquiry will be held into this incident when Jockey Mansour is available. Near the 1100m, had to be steadied when BETATHANTHEREST momentarily shifted ground inwards. Leaving the 600m, was slightly inconvenienced. Leaving the 100m, raced into a closing gap between DANILO DANILOVITCH and the running rails and clipped the heels of DANILO DANILOVITCH, stumbled badly dislodging Jockey Mansour. An inquiry on this incident will be held when Jockey Mansour is available.

CAPTAIN MIKE – An inquiry was held into the handling of CAPTAIN MIKE. Evidence was taken from Trainer V. Allet and Jockey Gates.

Trainer Allet explained that the gelding was having its fourth start of the season, competing in a higher rating band and over 1365m — a distance he considered not ideal for the horse. He added that, despite drawing wide, he believed CAPTAIN MIKE had sufficient early speed to lead in this field. Accordingly, he instructed his jockey to jump well and attempt to secure the lead.

Jockey Gates stated that his mount jumped well, and he urged it forward to comply with his instructions. However, after doing so, CAPTAIN MIKE grabbed the bit and became difficult to settle. When questioned, he added that had he tried harder to get the gelding to relax, CAPTAIN MIKE would likely have thrown its head and fought even more. He concluded that, had he ridden the horse previously, he would not have urged his mount so vigorously from the start to secure the lead.

After considering the evidence, the Stewards decided to take no further action other than to advise Jockey Gates that, given the particular nature of the Champ de Mars track — which rises uphill shortly after the 1365m start — in future, he should make a greater effort to allow his mounts a breather after exerting themselves to obtain the lead.

RACE 7: THE TOTELEPEP MOBILE APP CUP 1600M – [BM 31]

The start was delayed when Jockey Santana reported that he felt something amiss with MASTER OF MYSTERY and requested that the gelding be examined by the Regulatory Veterinarian. After examination, the Regulatory Veterinarian passed it fit to race. Upon the

Regulatory Veterinarian's advice, the Stewards maintained its participation in the race. When questioned, Jockey Santana stated that upon mounting the horse behind the stalls, he felt something amiss with the shoulder of his mount and concerned for his security, wanted MASTER OF MYSTERY checked.

HIGH KEY – Was slow to begin. Raced fiercely in the middle stages.

AMANCIO – Entering the home straight, was switched to the outside of MASTER OF MYSTERY to secure clear running.

MASTER OF MYSTERY – Hesitated at the start.

GRANDE ROSALIE – Leaving the 1200m, had to be steadied when awkwardly placed close to the heels of SECRET CIRCLE.

ARLINGTONS REVENGE – Leaving the 250m, was switched to the inside of GRANDE ROSALIE to secure clear running. Shortly thereafter, HIGH KEY which was following, endeavoured to improve into a tight gap between ARLINGTONS REVENGE and the running rails and was disappointed for a run. HIGH KEY was eased and was taken out to continue going forward.

RACE 8: THE CATMANDU PLATE 1500M – [0-25]

Light rain fell during the running of this race.

CIDER HOUSE RULES – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin.

CELESTIAL MAGMA – Was slow to begin and raced wide in the early and middle stages and commenced to give ground from the 400m. In doing so, inconvenienced RAINWATER which was attempting a run on its inside.

RAINWATER – Raced wide in the early stages. Was inconvenienced passing the 400m behind CELESTIAL MAGMA which was giving ground.

- Pre-race blood specimens were taken from all runners.
- Routine post-race urine and blood specimens were taken for analysis from all winners and from SMUTS (Race 2), CANFORD LIGHTS (Race 3), GLOBAL DOLLAR (Race 4), SECRET CIRCLE (Race 7) and OVERDOSE (Race 8).
- All Jockeys passed a breathalyser test and urine specimens were taken from Jockeys Taka, Santana and Ecroignard for analysis.
