### **GENERAL**

The following trainers and jockeys appeared before the Stipendiary Stewards to confirm their instructions and discuss their intentions in their respective races:

Race 6: DARING DASH (Trainer Mahadia and Jockey Perez)

### **RACE 1: PRIX MAHE DE LA BOURDONNAIS 1500M – [BM 41]**

BABYLON – Following the running of the race, the Stipendiary Stewards sounded the inquiry siren and viewed the video footage of the start. It was established that as the start was effected, BABYLON rushed its gate, sat back and fly jumped. The Stipendiary Stewards were of the opinion that BABYLON had not gained any advantage and jumped on terms with the field. The Stipendiary Stewards took no further action. BABYLON was urged forward to secure the lead, shortly after jumping.

IDITAROD TRAIL – Was slow into stride. Passing 1200m, Jockey Danielson adjusted his left side stirrup iron. Approaching the 450m, was switched to the outside of runners to improve its position and raced wide from then onwards.

SAN ANDREAS – Hanging inwards, in the back straight.

COLOUR OF MONEY – Passing the 250m, was switched to the inside of SAN ANDREAS to secure clear running.

### **RACE 2: THE BOURJOIS TROPHY 1400M – [0-20]**

SHORT CUT – Raced wide in the early and middle stages. Was hanging inwards, in the early stages of the home straight. Approaching the 150m, commenced to shift ground outwards, resulting in LINGOTTO which was improving behind and was hanging inwards, having to be taken out to continue going forward. Apprentice Jogahir was shown the video footage of the concluding stages of the race, was severely reprimanded and advised to ride his mounts out to the finish when he is in a position to do so.

CLOUD SEEDER – Jumped outwards.

LINGOTTO – Jumped awkwardly, shifted ground inwards and brushed CELESTIAL MAGMA thereafter was slow into stride. Approaching the 1300m, shifted ground inwards and made contact with OVERDOSE. Was hanging inwards, in the home straight, inconvenienced and had to be taken out near the 150m.

RIVER HAWK – Was slow into stride and crowded shortly after the start. Overraced in the middle stages and passing the 800m, had to be restrained when awkwardly placed close to the heels of CELESTIAL MAGMA. Leaving the 500m, was switched to outside of CELESTIAL MAGMA to improve its position.

OVERDOSE – Jumped inwards and was slow into stride.

LE QUARTIER – Knuckled on jumping and was slow into stride. Jumped outwards crowding RIVER HAWK.

#### **RACE 3: THE JO MALONE LONDON TROPHY 1450M – [0-26]**

LOVE ON TIME – Was hanging outwards, in the home straight.

CYBOTIX – Raced wide throughout.

ROCK OF EYE – Had its head turn sideways on jumping and was slow to begin.

SPIRITO SELVAGGIO – Was slow to begin and passing the 1300m, raced in restricted room between LOVE ON TIME and WILDE WORLD over a short distance and had to be eased. On inquiry it was established that after being slow to begin, SPIRITO SELVAGGIO was urged forward and near the 1300m was racing tight on the outside of WILDE WORLD and close to the hind quarters of LOVE ON TIME. Passing the 1300m WILD WORLD commenced to overrace and was eased when awkwardly placed close to the heels of SECRET CIRCLE and when being eased, shifted ground outwards carrying SPIRITO SELVAGGIO outwards onto the heels of LOVE ON TIME with SPIRITO SELVAGGIO having to be eased. The Stewards being of the opinion that the incident happened as a result of SPIRITO SELVAGGIO being urged into a tight gap, decided not to proceed further other than to remind jockey Segeon that he should exercise care at all time when riding in races. Dropped the bit from 700m, and had to be urged forward to maintain its position. Taken inwards near the 200m to secure clear running.

WILDE WORLD – Leaving the 200m, commenced to shift ground outwards, and brushed SPIRITO SELVAGGIO which was being taken inwards to improve on the inside of SECRET CIRCLE resulting in SPIRITO SELVAGGIO having to be switched further inwards to avoid

the heels of SECRET CIRCLE which had commenced to shift ground and in doing so, carried WILDE WORLD inwards.

### **RACE 4: THE 20/VIN TROPHY 1600M – [BM 51]**

Light rain fell during the running of this race.

SEA DANCE – Jumped awkwardly and bumped with SECRET OASIS. Near the 800 metres became awkwardly placed close to the heels of SECRET OASIS and was angled out to avoid its heels, was pushed back in by BRAVE BOMBER which stood its ground in the one-off position.

ROMAN'S REVENGE – Slow into stride. Leaving the 1000m, was switched to the outside of runners and had to stride forward to race closer to the lead. From 150m, it commenced to shift ground inwards resulting in BRAVE BOMBER which was improving on its inside and endeavouring to improve into a gap on the outside of SECRET OASIS, being cramped for galloping room and having to switch inwards to continue going forward. Trainer Hewitson requested to see video footage of the home straight. It was established that from leaving the 100m, ROMANS REVENGE commenced to shift ground inwards, and near the 50m, SECRET OASIS shifted outwards resulting in BRAVE BOMBER, which was endeavouring to improve into a gap between these two horses, being unable to do so. The Stipendiary Stewards being of the opinion that BRAVE BOMBER had not yet secured a run into the gap when the incident occurred and took no further action.

SECRET OASIS – Stumbled on jumping, shifted ground inwards, and came together with SEA DANCE. Shifted ground outwards over the concluding stages.

BRAVE BOMBER – From leaving the 900m, was switched outwards and improved on the outside of SEA DANCE thereafter resulting in SEA DANCE starting to race fiercely and becoming awkwardly placed close to the heels of SECRET OASIS and when being eased to avoid its heels, shifted outwards and was pushed back inwards by BRAVE BOMBER which maintained its position. Had to be switched inwards to continue going forward over the concluding stages.

**RACE 5: THE L'OCCITANE EN PROVENCE TROPHY 990M – [50+]**

Steady rain fell during the running of this race.

CAPTAIN BOMBSHELL – Was slow into stride. Leaving the 250m, was switched to the inside of UNITED PRINCE to secure clear running.

CAPTAIN LANNISTER – Approaching the 400m, was switched to the outside of runners to improve its position.

CARTEL BOSS – Jumped awkwardly and shifted ground outwards shortly thereafter. From approaching the 300m, commenced to give ground.

**RACE 6: THE GRAYS TROPHY 1365M – [BM 61]**

Prior to the running of the race, the penetrometer reading was 3.0 with the going downgraded to soft.

COLOUR MY FATE – Brushed the running rails entering the home straight.

DANILO DANILOVITCH – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin. Shortly thereafter, clipped the heels of MOONLIGHT TRADER and stumbled.

MOONLIGHT TRADER – Was slow to begin. Shortly thereafter, was carried inwards by DARING DASH which jumped inwards. From the 500m, commenced to give ground and was not persevered with in the home straight. Was found to be distressed post-race

COOL CAT – Approaching the 600m, commenced to give ground.

WARHEAD – Following the running of this race, the Stipendiary Stewards sounded the inquiry siren and viewed the video footage of the start. It was established that WARHEAD which had been fractious prior the start being effected, fly jumped when the start was effected with Jockey Joorawon becoming unbalanced and losing his left side stirrup iron which he regained passing the 1200m. Approaching the 700m, was switched outwards when awkwardly placed close to the heels of COOL CAT. Raced wide in the home turn.

**RACE 7: THE BEAUTY SUCCESS PRINCESS MAGARET CUP 1400M – [G1]**

On request of the Horse Racing Organiser, this race was rescheduled to run at 15h35.

SUN BLUSHED – From its wide draw, was taken across to race behind runners.

BLESS MY PATH – Fly jumped. Passing the 1300m, was awkwardly placed close to the heels of THE MAURITIAN which was steadied and taken out. From the 900m, was taken outwards in search of better going and raced wide from then onwards.

PORT LOUIS – Jumped awkwardly and was slow into stride.

ROYAL WULFF – Was slow to begin. From the 900m, was taken outwards in search of better going and raced wide from then onwards.

Jockey Ramsamy signed an admission of guilt for a contravention of Rule 43.2.4 in that he made an excessive celebratory gesture before the winning post whilst riding CUMBRE VEIJA. He was fined MUR 5,000.

Following the running of this race, the Stipendiary Stewards heard representations from jockeys on the prevailing weather conditions. The Stipendiary Stewards were of the opinion that the prevailing conditions for racing were unsafe due to poor visibility and after consultation with the Horse Racing Organiser, exercised their powers under Rule 12.12 to abandon race 8 and race 9 of this 13<sup>th</sup> race meeting. Consequently, all bets placed on race 8 and race 9 were ordered to be refunded.

- All Jockeys passed a breathalyser test and urine specimens were taken from Jockeys Ecroignard, Jogahir and Bhaugeerothee for analysis.

### **RACE 6: THE PHOENIX MAIDEN CUP 2400M – [G1] - 16<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER 2025**

Jockey Danielson signed an admission of guilt for a contravention of Rule 43.2.4 in that he failed to ensure that he did not make an excessive celebratory gesture before the winning post whilst riding GOOD COUNCIL. He was fined MUR 5,000.
