PUBLICATION OF FALSE AND MISLEADING ARTICLES BY L'EXPRESS

The Gambling Regulatory Authority (GRA) has taken note with great concern that a series of false and misleading articles have been published by L'Express on Thursday 07 and Friday 08 May 2026 about a purported decision of the Authority to prevent Jockey Rai Joorawon from riding during races and training sessions.

The Authority wishes to point out that no such decision has been taken.

Jockey Joorawon was present at the trackwork this Friday morning.

Furthermore, an article published by L'Express today alludes to the fact that the Authority has allegedly backtracked on its decision to prevent Jockey Joorawon from participating in races and trainings. This statement is again false and misleading as the Authority cannot backtrack on a decision that it has never taken, which again shows the poor ethical journalistic approach of the author of the article.

Given the above, the Authority reserves the right to take any legal actions as it deems appropriate against L'Express (La Sentinelle Ltd).
