RACE 1: THE BARBER – RED STAR TROPHY – 1450M – [0-20]

Following the running of the race, the Stipendiary Stewards sounded the inquiry siren and viewed the video footage of the start of the race. It was established that prior to the start being effected, **Stepping Out** rushed its gate and broke through. The Stipendiary Stewards, being of the opinion that **Stepping Out** had benefited from an advantageous start, declared the gelding a non-starter pursuant to Rule 402. Subsequently, all bets placed on **Stepping Out** were ordered to be refunded and a deduction of 2 cents per rupee were applied on winning bets.

Cosmic Captain – Shortly after the start, was bumped by **Malinois** on its hindquarters and turned sideways. Passing the 1000m, became awkwardly placed close to the heels of **Rainwater** and was momentarily taken out away from its heels. Passing the 450m, was taken out to improve its position. Passing the 400m, ran out of galloping room on the inside of **Amandla** and had to be eased. On inquiry, it was established that approaching the 450m, Apprentice Jogahir (**Grande Rosalie**) commenced to encourage his mount to move forward by tapping it with the whip on its neck, resulting in **Grande Rosalie** shifting ground outwards. At the same time, Apprentice Kulloo asked **Amandla** to improve on the outside of runners, with **Amandla** commencing to shift ground inwards. **Cosmic Captain** which was endeavoring to improve into a gap between these two horses, ran out of galloping room and had to be eased. After consideration, apprentices Kulloo (**Amandla**) and Jogahir (**Grande Rosalie**) were issued with a warning and advised to make more of an effort to straighten their mounts when they shift ground in future.

Kola Tonic – Jumped inwards, making contact with **Lingotto**. Raced wide in the early stages. Passing the 200m, when being ridden with the whip in the right hand, commenced to shift ground outwards and inconvenienced **Rainwater**. **Rainwater** was then switched to its inside passing the 100m to continue going forward. Jockey Rama was shown video footage of this incident, issued with a warning and told he is to stop riding with the whip and straighten his mounts in future.

Amandla – Jumped awkwardly, with apprentice Kulloo became unbalanced on jumping, with this gelding shifting ground outwards. Leaving the 600m, was switched to the outside of runners to improve its position and raced wide from then onwards. Passing the 400m, shifted ground inwards, crowding **Cosmic Captain**, who ran out of galloping room and had to be eased.

Trick Or Tequila – Slow to begin. Approaching the 450m, was switched to the outside of runners to improve its position.

Grande Rosalie – Raced wide in the early and middle stages. Passing the 450m, when being urged forward, shifted ground outwards, crowding **Cosmic Captain**.

Lingotto – Brushed on jumping. Raced wide throughout.

Malinois – Jumped awkwardly and brushed the left side of its gate. Shortly thereafter, shifted ground outwards and brushed **Lingotto**. It then shifted back inwards and bumped **Cosmic Captain** on its hindquarters, unbalancing the latter, and raced in restricted room between **Cosmic Captain** and **Lingotto**. It was then steadied and lost ground. Leaving the 250m, was switched to the outside of runners to improve its position and raced very wide into the turn.

Rainwater – Approaching the 200m, was switched to the inside of **Kola Tonic** to secure clear running.

Moon Jumper – Slow to begin. Approaching the 300m, for some distance, was held up when unable to improve from behind **Stepping Out**, which was giving ground. Passing the 250m, it was switched out from behind **Stepping Out** to secure clear running.

RACE 2: THE INDIANOIL PETROCARD CUP – 1400M – [B.36]

Acting on veterinary advice that **Not In Doubt** was lame near fore, it was withdrawn at 11h26. In view of this, all bets placed on **Not In Doubt** were ordered to be refunded, and a deduction of 5 cents per rupee was applied on winning bets prior to the withdrawal of **Not In Doubt**.

Warbird – Jumped outwards. Approaching the 150m, commenced to shift ground outwards.

Zacatoo – Slow into stride. Passing the 300m, was switched to the outside of runners to secure clear running. Approaching the 100m, was switched to the inside of **Warbird** to continue going forward.

Balouchi – In the early stages, was urged forward but failed to muster speed.

San Andreas – Shortly after the start, Jockey Nunes adjusted his left-side stirrup iron. Raced fiercely in the middle stages.

RACE 3: THE IOML REWARDS CUP – 1500M – [B.41]

Fireflare – Jumped outwards. Passing the 500m, was switched to the outside of runners to improve its position and raced wide from then onwards.

Sound Of The Sea – Jumped awkwardly. Approaching the 1400m, was crowded for room on the inside of **Taking Silk**, which in turn was being taken in by **Wugug**, which shifted ground inwards when insufficiently clear. In this incident, **Taking Silk** raced in restricted room on the inside of **Wugug** and had to be checked, losing its position. Leaving the 1300m, was eased when awkwardly placed close to the heels of **Wugug**, when **Wugug** shifted in momentarily. Leaving the 1100m, commenced to race fiercely and leaving the 1000m, had to be steadied when awkwardly placed close to the heels of **Summer Snow**.

Summer Snow – Leaving the 900m, Jockey Nunes re-adjusted his right-side stirrup iron.

Wugug – Leaving the 900m, was switched to the outside of **Fireflare** and allowed to stride forward to race closer to the lead. Jockey Danielson reported that this filly was hanging inwards throughout. When questioned, Jockey Danielson explained that leaving the 1300m, he settled his mount in the one-out one-back position behind **Fireflare**. However, leaving the 1000m, feeling the pace was a sedate one and **Fireflare** was not improving on the outside of the leader, he opted to take his mount out and urge it forward in order to secure a position closer to the lead. He added that leaving the 450m, when asked for an effort, **Wugug** failed to quicken and was hanging inwards, being disappointing. A subsequent veterinary examination of **Wugug** revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Tsunami Warning – Jumped inwards, making contact with **Taking Silk**. Approaching the 1300m, momentarily raced tight onto **Taking Silk** and leaving the 1300, when being taken out to relieve the pressure, shifted out and raced wide for some distance. Leaving the 900m, commenced to race fiercely and approaching the 800m, was switched out to avoid the heels of **Sound Of The Sea**. Approaching the 200m, was switched to the inside of **Sound Of The Sea** to secure clear running.

Taking Silk – Jumped outwards, making contact with **Tsunami Warning**. Passing the 1400m, raced in restricted room on the inside of **Wugug** and had to be checked, losing its position. On inquiry, Jockey Danielson (**Wugug**) signed an Admission Of Guilt for a contravention of Rule 414 (g) for careless riding and was suspended for one Mauritian race meeting.

RACE 4: THE BOUNGI & POPS FAMILY TROPHY – 1500M – [B.51]

Just Var – Leaving the 50m, was switched to the outside of **Rich Folks Hoax** to continue going forward.

Princeofgreen – Fly-jumped and was slow into stride.

Makazole – Leaving the 900m, commenced to race fiercely and passing the 800m, had to be steadied when awkwardly placed close to the heels of **Stated** and when being steadied, got its head up, racing ungenerously for some distance. Leaving the 200m, was switched to the inside of **Stated** to secure clear running, at the same time, **Stated** commenced to shift ground inwards, resulting in **Makazole** having to be taken out to continue going forward.

Rich Folks Hoax – Raced fiercely in the middle stages and approaching the 600m, was switched to the outside of **Just Var** and raced wide from then onwards.

Stated – Passing the 1200m, was momentarily crowded for room on the inside of **Just Var**. On inquiry, apprentice Appou (**Just Var**) was issued with a warning and advised to make his intentions known clear when riding in races, and to ensure that he is to allow for room to riders on his inside. Was hanging inwards in the middle stages.

Bounceback – Slow into stride. Approaching the 300m, was switched to the outside of runners to improve its position and raced wide into the home straight. Leaving the 150m, commenced to shift ground inwards, resulting in Jockey Van Niekerk putting his whip away passing the 50m and straightening his mount.

Tyrion Lannister – Jumped awkwardly.

Blue Bay – Leaving the 400m, was switched to the outside of runners to improve its position and raced wide into the home straight.

Lets Play Poker – Slow into stride. Passing the 1100m, was steadied when awkwardly placed close to the heels of **Spelling Bee** and momentarily got its head up. Approaching the 300m, for some distance, was held up when unable to improve from behind **Tyrion Lannister**. Leaving the 250m, was switched to the inside of runners to secure an inside run.

RACE 6: THE SOPHOMORE TRIAL – INDIANOIL SERVO CUP – LISTED – 1365M

Mfethu – Jumped awkwardly and shifted ground outwards, brushing the left side of its gate. Leaving the 1300m, was slightly inconvenienced by **Blackjack Randall**. Leaving the 250m, was switched to the inside of **Blackjack Randall** to secure clear running.

Military Force – Jumped awkwardly and shifted ground inwards, brushing the right side of its gate, resulting in Jockey Corrales losing the use of his right-side stirrup iron, which he regained approaching the 1200m. In this incident, **Military Force** lost ground on the rest of the field. Came off the crossing at the 450m awkwardly. When questioned, Jockey Corrales explained that his mount, which was having its first run in Mauritius, was very nervous and became fractious when being loaded. He added that it jumped awkwardly with his right leg brushing the right side of its gate, with him losing the use of his right-side stirrup iron, becoming unbalanced and only

regained it leaving the 1300m, resulting in him racing further back in the field than expected. He further stated that over the final turn, **Military Force** raced green and was unbalanced around the turn, came off the crossing awkwardly and once balanced, quickened nicely.

Siriano – Hesitated at the start and was slow to begin. Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Passing the 850m, had to be eased when awkwardly placed close to the heels of **Mfethu** and in doing so, got its head up and shifted ground outwards, bumping **Diamond Days**.

Diamond Days – Half-reared at the start. Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Leaving the 900m, when still over-racing, got its head up and raced ungenerously when being restrained to the avoid the heels of **Ashikule**. Passing the 300m, was switched to the outside of runners to improve its position and made the turn into the home straight very wide. Was hanging inwards in the home straight.

Blackjack Randall – Shortly after the start, shifted ground inwards.

Ashikule – Was hanging outwards from leaving the 450m.

RACE 7: THE IOML ENERGISING MAURITIUS CUP – MIDDLE STAKES – 1365M

The start was delayed when **William Rufus** refused to proceed to the paddock.

Betathanotherest – Slow into stride. Approaching the 900m, when the pace slackened, became awkwardly placed close to the heels of **William Rufus** and had to be restrained, and when being restrained, raced ungenerously. Approaching the 200m, was switched to the inside of **Daring Dash** to secure clear running.

William Rufus – Slow into stride. Approaching the 1100m, was urged forward, and leaving the 1000m, had to be steadied when awkwardly placed close to the heels of **World of Pleasure**, which was being taken inwards. When questioned, Jockey Rama explained that he felt that this gelding wanted to stop and as such, he urged it forward to maintain the position behind the leaders. He added that leaving the 1000m, the pace slackened, resulting in Jockey Danielson (**Crescent**) taking

his mount out to avoid the heels of **Daring Dash**. As a result, he found himself awkwardly placed close to the heels of **Crescent** and had to steady.

Danilo Danilovitch – Slow to begin. Raced fiercely in the middle stages and passing the 800m, had to be steadied when awkwardly placed close to the heels of **Daring Dash**.

World Of Pleasure – Jockey Van Niekerk adjusted his left side stirrup iron approaching the 1300m. Leaving the 1200m, had difficulty in negotiating the turn and shifted ground outwards. Passing the 1000m, when being taken back inwards, inconvenienced **William Rufus**. Raced wide from leaving the 900m to the 600m. Was hanging outwards from leaving the 450m and when asked for an effort, failed to quicken and was not persevered with. When questioned, Jockey Van Niekerk explained that this gelding, which was running for the first time in Mauritius, raced wide and fiercely in the early and middle stages, and that when asked for an effort leaving the 450m, failed to quicken and tired badly over the concluding stages.

RACE 8: THE HANDLERS CHALLENGE TROPHY – 1365M – [0-26]

Gang Leader – Slow to begin and was contacted by **Canford Lights**, which had shifted ground outwards on jumping. Jockey Van Niekerk lost the use of his left side stirrup iron, which he quickly regained. Approaching the 1200m, was cramped for room on the inside of **Dwight Eisenhower** and had to be checked. On inquiry, Jockey Bheekary (**Dwight Eisenhower**) signed an Admission of Guilt for a contravention of Rule 414 (g) for careless riding and was suspended for one Mauritian race meeting. Leaving the 1100m, commenced to race fiercely and approaching the 900m, had to be steadied when awkwardly placed close to the heels of **Canford Lights**. Leaving the 450m, was switched to the outside of runners to improve its position and raced very wide form then onwards.

Cape Cannery – Raced wide in the early stages. Leaving the 450m, was switched from behind **Midnight Flyer** to improve its position. Inconvenienced and was carried wide by **Paved With Gold** passing the 300m. In this incident, inconvenienced **Dwight Eisenhower** on its outside, with **Dwight Eisenhower** having to be switched to the inside to continue going forward. Approaching the 200m, was switched to the inside of runners to continue going forward and in doing so, carried **Dwight Eisenhower** inwards.

Dwight Eisenhower – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin. Inconvenienced approaching the 250m and had to be switched to the inside to continue going forward. Carried inwards by **Cape Cannery** passing the 200m.

Midnight Flyer – Commenced to give ground from leaving the 450m and was not persevered with, finishing tailed off. When questioned regarding its apparent poor performance, Jockey Danielson explained that this gelding was having its second outing in Mauritius and had pleased in its first outing over the 990m, quickening to finish 4th. He further explained that after that run, **Midnight Flyer** had improved at track work and as such, a forward showing was expected today. He added that after jumping well, he urged his mount forward and managed to secure a position close to the lead, racing in a relaxed manner. He further stated that passing the 400m, when asked for an effort, **Midnight Flyer** failed to respond and started to give ground, with him not pursuing his effort leaving the 150m and the gelding finishing tailed off. He concluded that at the pull up, **Midnight Flyer** was trotting sound, was not blowing and that in his opinion, may be having an underlying problem.

Paved With Gold – Jumped awkwardly and shifted ground outwards. Over-raced in the middle stages. Passing the 300m, was switched outwards from behind **Kaisarissa** to improve its position and in doing so, inconvenienced and carried **Cape Cannery** wide into the home straight. In this incident, **Cape Cannery** inconvenienced **Dwight Eisenhower** on its outside, with **Dwight Eisenhower** having to be switched to the inside to continue going forward. On inquiry, Apprentice Sophie signed an Admission Of Guilt for a contravention of Rule 414 (g) for careless riding and was suspended for one Mauritian race meeting. Leaving the 250m, when being ridden with the whip on the right hand, commenced to shift ground outwards. Apprentice Sophie was issued with a severe warning and told he is to stop riding with the whip and straighten his mounts in future.

Canford Lights – Jumped awkwardly and shifted ground outwards, making contact with **Gang Leader**.

Trainer Mahadia signed an Admission Of Guilt for a breach of Rule 126 (x) in that being the Trainer responsible for **Transonic**, he failed to ensure that treatments done by his registered Veterinarian to that horse on 5th June 2026 were immediately entered in the stable treatment register. Trainer Mahadia was fined Rs 10,000.

- b) Routine post-race urine and blood specimens were taken for analysis from all winners,
- c) All Jockeys passed a breathalyzer test, and urine specimens were taken from Jockeys Mansour, Nunes and Rama for analysis.
