PRESS COMMUNIQUE

SAMPLING OF HORSE TRANSONIC

Following routine pre-race sampling procedures, the Designated Laboratory reported to the Gambling Regulatory Authority (GRA) at 06:57 p.m, on Friday 12 June 2026, that Triamcinolone Acetonide was detected in a Blood sample coded HRD-972-F at a concentration level of approximately 100 pg/ml.

The Designated Laboratory pointed out that there is currently no internationally recognised screening limit for Triamcinolone Acetonide in plasma. However, the applicable international screening limit in urine is 500 pg/ml.

Following verification, code HRD-972-F was attributed to horse **TRANSONIC**, trained by Mr Mahadia, which is carded to race in Race 8 of this Saturday's race meeting.

Consequently, the Regulatory Veterinarian of the GRA took a urine sample of horse, **TRANSONIC**, at 5:00 a.m, this morning, Saturday, 13 June 2026.

Following the analysis of this urine sample, the Designated Laboratory confirmed that the concentration of Triamcinolone Acetonide was below the applicable international screening limit of 500 pg/ml in urine.

In the light of the above, **TRANSONIC** will participate in Race 8, "The Special Idol Plate" as carded.

An investigation has been opened into the matter.

The GRA remains committed to ensuring the integrity of horse racing in Mauritius through the strict application of internationally recognised testing and regulatory standards as provided under the Rules of Racing.
