RACE 1: THE EXPERTISE PLATE – 1500M – [B.36]

All About Love – From the start, was taken across to race behind runners.

Canford Club – Fly-jumped, brushed the right side of its stall, and was slow to begin. Leaving the 1300m, was carried wide by **Dalmeny Factor**. It was then eased to secure a position on the rails behind **Dalmeny Factor**. Passing the 450m, was switched to the outside of runners to improve its position and raced wide from then onwards. Was hanging inwards in the home straight.

Dalmeny Factor – Slow to begin. Approaching the 1300m, commenced to race fiercely and leaving the 1300m, was switched to the outside of **My Archangel** to avoid its heels and in doing so, carried **Canford Club** wider on the track. Following this incident, **Dalmeny Factor** continued to over-race. Leaving the 450m, commenced to hang outwards, resulting in **Canford Club**, which was improving on its outside, being carried out further.

RACE 2: THE DAMBUSTER PLATE – 1650M – [B.31]

High Key – Was hanging inwards throughout the race. Passing the 450m, shifted ground inwards and momentarily crowded **Lava County**.

Zooberi – Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages and passing the 1500m, threw its head sideways. Approaching the 250m, was switched to the outside of **New World** to improve its position. Was hanging inwards over the concluding stages.

Lava County – Stood flat-footed and was slow to begin, subsequently losing ground at the start. Passing the 450m, was momentarily crowded for room on the inside of **High Key**. Was hanging inwards from leaving the 300m and approaching the 250m, brushed **Backpacker**, shifted out and raced wide in home straight wide.

Backpacker – Slow to begin. Brushed by **Lava County** approaching the 250m.

RACE 3: THE VALUE PLUS SMS 24/7 CUP – 1365M – [0-26]

Carnarvon – Shifted ground outwards on jumping.

Dwight Eisenhower – Jumped awkwardly, brushing the right side of its gate. Approaching the 1100m, was awkwardly placed close to the heels of **Midnight Flyer** and when being eased, got its head up and raced ungenerously for some distance. Passing the 600m, was switched to the outside of **Midnight Flyer** and approaching the 450m, was momentarily cramped for room when **Cape Cannery** shifted ground inwards. Passing the 450m, was held up for some distance when unable to improve from behind **Carnarvon**. Leaving the 100m, was disappointed for a run between **William Blake** and **Jet Blackfire**, when **William Blake** commenced to shift ground outwards away from the whip.

Jet Blackfire – Slow to begin and shortly thereafter, was squeezed out between **William Blake** and **Cape Cannery** and as a result, stumbled. Came off the crossing at the 1300m awkwardly and

shortly thereafter, when being settled, threw its head up and commenced to shift ground outwards, and in doing so, carried **Cape Cannery** wider on the track. Following this incident, **Jet Blackfire** continued to race fiercely and proved very difficult to control. Passing the 900m, when still over-racing and hanging outwards, was allowed to stride forward to secure a position closer to the lead. Was hanging outwards in the home straight, and over the concluding stages, inconvenienced **Cape Cannery**, with **Cape Cannery** being disappointed for a run. Jockey Schwarz was shown the video footage of this incident, issued with a warning, and advised to stop riding with his whip and straighten his mounts earlier than he did on this occasion .

Midnight Flyer – Passing the 250m, was switched to the inside of **William Blake** to secure clear running.

Cape Cannery – Shifted ground inwards on jumping, brushing the right side of its gate and squeezing out **Jet Blackfire**, resulting in that gelding stumbling shortly after the start. Carried wide leaving the 1300m. Approaching the 400m, was switched to the outside of **Carnarvon** to improve its position and raced wide from then onwards. Over the concluding stages, was disappointed for a run between **Jet Blackfire** and **Carnarvon**, when **Jet Blackfire** commenced to shift ground outwards.

William Blake – Raced wide in the early stages. Leaving the 100m, commenced to shift ground outwards away from the whip, resulting in **Dwight Eisenhower**, which was following, being disappointed for a run between **William Blake** and **Jet Blackfire**. Jockey Rama was shown the video footage of this incident, issued with a warning, and advised to stop riding with the whip and straighten his mounts earlier than he did on this occasion.

RACE 4: THE VALUE PLUS SMS FOOTBALL & HORSERACING CUP – 1365M – [B.41]

Babylon – Fractious in its stall prior to the start being effected. Leaving the 1300m, was inconvenienced and had to be steadied when awkwardly placed close to the heels of **Not In**

Doubt, which was being taken in. Approaching the 1100m, commenced to race fiercely and when being restrained, got its head up and raced ungenerously for some distance.

Cool Cat – Commenced to give ground from approaching the 450m.

Iditarod Trail – Slow to begin.

Nou Praat Jy – Hesitated at the start and was slow to begin. Raced fiercely in the middle stages. Carried wide approaching the 450m and raced wide from then onwards.

Siriano – Restless in its stall prior to the start being effected. Had its head turned sideways as the stalls opened and was slow to begin.. Approaching the 1200m, when being restrained, got its head up and shifted ground outwards, proving difficult to control. Raced wide from approaching the 1000m. It was then allowed to stride forward to secure a position closer to the lead. Leaving the 250m, commenced to shift ground outwards and carried **Ibhele** outwards in the early stages of the home straight. Was hanging inwards over the concluding 50m. When questioned with regards to its apparent improved performance, Trainer Awotar explained that this gelding had been disappointing to date as it had pleased at trackwork, but in a race it had proved to over-race and been unable to properly negotiate the turns. He added that the Stable was expecting an improved run today as he was of the opinion that there would be pace in the race which would suit **Siriano**. He further added that the improved run can also be accredited to the fact that down the backstraight, Jockey Van Niekerk had let the gelding stride along instead of fighting it which enabled it to breathe and find the necessary resources to quicken in the home straight.

Not In Doubt – Leaving the 1300m, was taken in to secure a position on the rails. **Babylon**, which was following, was inconvenienced and had to be steadied when awkwardly placed close to the heels of **Not In Doubt**. Jockey Bhaugerothee was shown the video footage of the section of this race and advised to allow for more room to horses racing on his inside in future. Approaching the 150m, when being ridden with the whip in the right hand, commenced to shift ground outwards.

Iko Iko – Raced wide in the early stages. Approaching the 450m, was switched to the outside of **Ibhele** and in doing so, carried **Nou Praat Jy** wider on the track. **Nou Praat Jy** raced wide from then onwards.

Ibhele – Carried outwards in the early stages of the home straight.

RACE 5: THE VALUE PLUS INSTANT ONLINE DEPOSIT CUP – 1500M – [B.46]

Opague – Leaving the 800m, was switched to the outside of **Summer Snow** to improve its position and in doing so, inconvenienced **View Of The World**. **Opague** raced wide from then onwards. On inquiry, it was established that the pace had slowed down the backstraight, with **View Of The World** and **Opague** commencing to over-race. **Opague** was then switched to the outside of **Summer Snow** to avoid its heels and in doing so, slightly inconvenienced **View Of The World**. After consideration, the Stipendiary Stewards decided not to proceed further with this inquiry, other than to advise Jockey Schwarz that he is to be well clear of horses before shifting ground in future.

Summer Snow – Jumped awkwardly and shifted ground outwards, brushing the left side of its gate and brushed **Sea Dance** on its hindquarters. Passing the 1200m, had to steady when close to the heels of **Sea Dance**, which was being taken in to secure a position on the rails.

Sea Dance – Stumbled on jumping. Brushed on its hindquarters shortly thereafter. Commenced to give ground from leaving the 300m and was not persevered with over the concluding stages.

View Of The World – Slow to begin. Leaving the 900m, shifted ground inwards momentarily and bumped **Comedy Club**. Approaching the 800m, commenced to race fiercely and had to be taken out when awkwardly placed close to the heels of **Opague**. Leaving the 800m, was inconvenienced when **Opague** was switched to the outside of **Summer Snow** to improve its position. Leaving the 250m, was switched to the outside of runners to secure clear running and raced wide into the home straight. Was hanging inwards over the concluding stages.

Comedy Club – Jumped awkwardly, shifted ground outwards, and was slow to begin. It was then taken across to race behind runners. Raced fiercely in the middle stages. Leaving the 1000m, when still over-racing, commenced to pull very hard when **View Of The World** improved on its outside, and when being restrained, got its head up and raced ungenerously. Was bumped leaving the 900m.

RACE 6: THE VALUE PLUS – MTC SOPHOMORE CHALLENGE CUP – 1500M

Zacatoo – Jumped outwards, making contact with **The Centurion**, which had jumped inwards. Passing the 100m, Apprentice Taka momentarily lost the use of his left-side rein, which he regained shortly thereafter. When questioned on whether specific instructions were given to Apprentice Taka, Trainer Nagadoo explained that **Zacatoo** being a strong galloper, was trapped behind the leader on the fence in his last outing and he did not want that to happen again. As such, he explained that his instructions were for Apprentice Taka to jump and lead. In the event that he could not lead, to try be closer to the pace and avoid the fence if possible so as not to be balked once again.

Exalted Love – Threw its head on jumping and was slow to begin. Leaving the 250m, was switched to the outside of runners to improve its position and raced wide into the home straight.

Blackjack Randall – Approaching the 1200m, when **Zacatoo** improved on its outside, commenced to race fiercely and when being restrained, threw its head up and raced ungenerously for some distance. Leaving the 450m, was switched to the outside of **Boom Town** and raced in restricted room on the inside of **Zacatoo** for a short distance.

The Centurion – Jumped inwards, making contact with **Zacatoo**, which had jumped outwards. Failed to quicken when asked for an effort leaving the 300m. When questioned regarding its apparent poor performance,, Jockey Danielson explained that this gelding had pleased in the lead-up to this race and as such, expected a forward showing today. He added that although jumping out fairly, he managed to secure a position in midfield following **Zacatoo**. He further added that from then onwards, his mount raced in a relaxed manner. However, when he asked it for an effort leaving the 400m, it stayed one-paced and was extremely disappointing. Jockey Danielson concluded that at the pull up, **The Centurion** was sound at the trot and simply felt flat today. A subsequent veterinary examination of **The Centurion** revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Boom Town – Came off the 1300m and 1000m crossings awkwardly.

RACE 7: THE VALUE PLUS LEVÉ PILÉ & BONUS SYSTEM CUP – MIDDLE STAKES – 1500M

Zoomie – Slow into stride. Leaving the 250m, was switched to the inside of **Havana Moon** to secure clear running and in doing so, carried **The Grey King** inwards.

Gimmeanotherchance – Jumped awkwardly. Raced fiercely in the middle stages and passing the 800m, had to be steadied to avoid the heels of **Just Var**. Approaching the 400m, was switched to the outside of **Just Var** and raced wide into the home straight. Was hanging inwards in the home straight, with Apprentice Taka switching his whip to his right hand.

The Grey King – Slow to begin. Carried inwards leaving the 250m. Jockey Van Niekerk reported that this gelding raced fiercely throughout. A subsequent veterinary examination of **The Grey King** revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Just Var – Slow to begin. Raced wide in the early stages and leaving the 1200m, was urged forward to secure a position closer to the lead.

RACE 8: THE VALUE PLUS RESPONSIBLE GAMBLING – PINNACLE STAKES – 1400M

The start was delayed when **Boundless Energy** was re-saddled behind the starting stalls.

Quasiforsure – Threw its head on jumping and was slow to begin. Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages.

Captain Bombshell – Passing the 1300m, when being settled, got its head up and raced ungenerously for some distance. Raced fiercely in the middle stages.

Unzen – Commenced to give ground from approaching the 400m.

Captain Lannister – Raced wide in the early and middle stages. Carried wide leaving the 450m and raced wide from then onwards. Was brushed on its hindquarters passing the 250m and shifted ground outwards, inconveniencing **Betathantherest**. Passing the 100m, was momentarily inconvenienced between **Betathantherest**, which was hanging inwards, and **Royal Wulff**, which had shifted ground outwards slightly away from the whip.

Boundless Energy – Over-raced in the early stages and leaving the 1100m, was switched out from behind **Unzen** to avoid its heels.

Bless My Path – Passing the 450m, was switched to the outside of **Unzen** and in doing so, carried **Captain Lannister** wider on the track, with **Captain Lannister** racing wide from then onwards. Leaving the 400m, was switched to the outside of **Boundless Energy** to improve its position.

Royal Wulff – Slow into stride. Passing the 250m, improved into a tight gap between **Bless My Path** and **Captain Lannister**, and in doing so, brushed **Captain Lannister** on its hindquarters. Passing the 100m, shifted ground outwards slightly away from the whip.

Betathantherest – Approaching the 800m, for some distance, commenced to over-race and was momentarily awkwardly placed close to the heels of **Captain Lannister**. Passing the 450m, was switched to the outside of runners to improve its position and raced very wide into the home straight. Inconvenienced passing the 250m. Was hanging inwards passing the 100m.
